Object: REACH – COMPLIANCE

We do hereby confirm the compliance to the Regulation (EC) n. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) for the substances contained in our supplied products.

We want to make it clear, that per the recovery's industry, an actual registration of the recovered substances will not be provided if any other legal entity proceeds with the registration (art. 2, 7, d)).

We want to stress that the finished-products such as: bars, wire rods, coils, flats, angle bars, etc. are defined as **articles** without intentional release of substances (art. 7 REACH) and consequently they are outside the scope of the REACH Regulation.

All the produced alloys and articles do not contain any SVHC substances in a concentration above 0,1 %, as listed into the Candidate List (<https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>).

We will keep the market up to date about any possible use of SVHC substances, not currently included into the Candidate List, which could be included during future revisions. It is a legal obligation to inform you as soon as a substance classified as SVHC is present in a concentration above 0,1 % weight by weight (w/w) in some articles produced by Acciaierie Valbruna SpA.

We confirm and acknowledge REACH and REACH Annex XVII and confirm that products sold to the market may contain substances subject to restriction: Nickel (12% ca.), point 27 of Annex XVII.

In addition, we declare that we shall update the market on any change of articles delivered by us that will influence this declaration. We also declare that we are aware that Annex XVII may be amended from time to time and we committed to send an updated declaration when there are new amendments to Annex XVII to REACH.
